ADMISSION PROCESS

Questions:

How can I receive more information about Coventry?

What is offered in your program? What is the cost? How do you qualify? How long are the sessions? Can someone attend part time?

We have listed several steps to help guide you in understanding the procedure for placement in the Coventry Program.

1. Information

You may inquire by email (info@coventryreserve.org) or phone (214-498-7298) We will be glad to provide information or answer your questions regarding our program, and in general, try to give you an idea of the type of individual who might benefit from our program.

2. Coventry Tour

If you feel the applicant's needs seem to be within the range of our staff expertise, we will ask you to schedule a tour of Coventry. The tour is invaluable and will give you a first-hand look at the program in action and of the facilities utilized to enhance our training. On this tour you will also gain further insight into the Coventry organization, our history, our expectations, and future plans.

3. Application

Should you feel that Coventry has the program to fit your needs, you should complete an application available from our office. The Admissions Committee conducts a thorough study of the information provided, determines placement availability and suitability of each applicant, and notifies you whether or not to continue with the next step in the admissions process. The next step is an interview/meeting with the Admissions Committee.

4. Interview

Both the Parent/Guardian and the Applicant will be notified to meet with appropriate committee members for further discussion and review of information requested on the application in addition to other areas such as: Procedures for Enrollment/Dismissal, Medical History, Specific Goals and Individual Program Possibilities, Expected Behavior, Conduct etc.

5. Admissions Committee Recommendation

The Admissions Committee will notify you of their recommendation. The Committee may decide one of the following at this time; candidate is not accepted at this time, or the candidate is accepted on a probationary basis. All new participants are accepted on a probationary basis.

6. Enrollment
