

2016 TUITION INFORMATION

TUITION FEES

Coventry is currently offering two 5 month sessions per year. The first session begins mid-January through early June. The second session begins mid-July through early December. Each week Coventry is open Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday from 9:00 am to 3:00pm.

- Tuition for full session (4x per week) \$3,400 (\$680.00 per month) due January or July 15
- Tuition for partial session (3x per week) \$2,550 (\$510.00 per month) due 15th each month
- Tuition for partial session (2x per week) \$1,700 (\$340.00 per month) due 15th each month

Our tuition charges provide a great foundation for our operating expenses; however, it only covers a percentage of the cost it requires to run our program. The remainder of the funding is provided through our gracious donors. It is always Coventry's desire to keep our services affordable to as many families as possible; therefore we will continually endeavor to keep our tuition as low as possible. Adjustments for the natural flow of the economy and inflation may increase tuition if or when necessary.

Initial evaluation fee is \$250.00. This is a non-refundable fee and is due at the time the potential participant is evaluated.

Holidays, such as Memorial Day, Spring Break, and Thanksgiving have been considered in the average used to calculate the monthly tuition rates based on number of days attended per session. However any necessary bad weather days, or other unforeseen circumstances that cause Coventry to close on a scheduled day, will not constitute tuition adjustments or make-up days.

At the end of each session, we send a closing financial statement for each participant that outlines any outstanding balance or credit for that participant for that session. If there is a balance due from the prior session, the participant will be in-eligible to register/attend the upcoming session until the balance is paid.

Annual registration takes place in December for each upcoming year to provide opportunity for any necessary schedule changes. Attendance days will remain the same unless requested by parent/guardian and adjusted by the program director according to program space availability.

In consideration for financial and staff planning, which is done for the calendar year, a 30 day notice or payment of one month's tuition for any withdrawal from the program prior to December is requested.

TUITION TAX DEDUCTION INFORMATION

In the past, we have been asked if the tuition at Coventry is tax deductible. Guidelines and tax laws are always changing; however, as a general rule if you receive services for money given, the amount would not be deductible as a donation. There may be the possibility of qualifying the tuition as a medical deduction based on the guidelines related to that particular deduction as it relates to each individual situation. In order to hold Coventry harmless of providing incorrect, outdated or misunderstood tax advice, we encourage each family to solicit specific tax advice from their own CPA.
